

The number of tests available for Ohioans continues to be limited. Several outpatient testing centers have been set up to collect specimens from patients who have a physician's order with them for a COVID-19 test to be performed.

Patients cannot simply walk into testing centers, physician offices, or a hospital and request to be tested. CDC guidelines must be followed for testing. Kettering Health Network, including Kettering Mobile Care, is not able to transport patients to testing sites.
